As mentioned above, the re-surfacing design of the playground is based on our four House Colours. Please find following information regarding the various colours including who and what they represent with the corresponding values that underpin the House colours.

Portland - Blue - Value of Community:

The Victorian town where the idea was born to establish schools that would be run by a special group of dedicated Nuns who would not be under the direct control of local Bishops and would work mainly with the poor.

MacKillop – Yellow – Value of Courage:

Mary Mackillop was the foundress of the Sisters of St. Joseph and is a direct link to the establishment of our own school, Corpus Christi. Mary MacKillop was beatified in 1995, our 10th Anniversary year and Canonised a Saint on 17th October 2010, our 25th Anniversary Year.

Penola – Green – Value of Learning:

The South Australian town where the first school was established in very humble beginnings, not unlike Corpus Christi in 1985!

Woods – Red – Value of Service:

Father Julian Woods was the co-founder of the Sisters of St. Joseph and their Spiritual Leader in their early days of formation.
