## Corpus Christi Primary School Term 2 Arrangements and Supervision

On the advice of the Victorian Chief Health Officer and the Catholic Education Commission Victoria (CECV) I advise, like all Victorian Catholic schools, that Corpus Christi Primary School will be transitioning to remote and flexible learning arrangements for Term 2.

The Chief Health Officer has advised that these arrangements should remain in place for the duration of Term 2 2020 and will then be reviewed.

The Victorian Premier, Daniel Andrews has stated that "the message is **clear**: all children who **can** learn at home **must** learn from home – with exceptions only in extremely limited circumstances."

With this in mind, Corpus Christi is able to make exceptions only for those students who cannot work from home, and vulnerable students.

Please note that these students will be supervised so they can complete the online and remote learning that will be offered to all students in our school. These students will not receive any additional support from teaching staff other than what those working remotely are receiving. This is according to the guidelines stipulated by the Education Department and CECV.

Social distancing provisions will continue to be made to ensure safety for teachers and students. The health and wellbeing of all in our community remains paramount.
