

Return to School Update 12th May 2020

Dear Parents / Carers,

This morning Premier Daniel Andrews announced that all Victorian students will be back in class by Tuesday 9th June as part of the state government's easing of coronavirus restrictions.

Premier Daniel Andrews has reassured parents that schools are safe, but has explained that communities need to brace for a different schooling experience. A range of health and safety measures to keep children and staff safe while at school will be in place when children return to school. These measures will be communicated to all families before we return to school.

As announced by the Premier, Monday 25th May has been designated as a pupil free day to enable all staff to prepare for the resumption of classes at school.

Foundation, Grades One and Two, will be able to return to school on Tuesday 26th May. (During this time, we will continue to be open to students in Grades 3-6 of essential workers and those for whom there is no adult at home.) From Tuesday 9th June, Grades 3 to 6 will join their schoolmates at school.

We certainly look forward to planning for our children to return to school. We miss them and look forward to having them back in our classrooms!

More information will follow as we receive further advice and updates from Catholic Education Melbourne (CEM) and the Department of Education and Training (DET).
