Once again, it is very important to be aware that you can only do what is possible in your family situation in relation to Home Learning. Teachers will be doing their best to stay in regular contact with all students in their home groups and we will be using all of our staff members to ensure ongoing contact throughout this time.

It is important to be aware that teachers are required to support in managing and supervising children who need to be onsite, whilst also conducting Remote Learning. Therefore, there may be times when a response from your home group teacher may be delayed – but be assured that they will get back to you as soon as possible.

Please feel free to contact us at school if you are having any difficulties that we can help with. These are difficult times and families are under stress in all sorts of ways. This is a time when our community needs to keep an eye out for every person so we can look after each other. These are very challenging times for all of us – but together we can do the best for your children
