START OF DAY AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

<u>Start of Day</u>

<u>Yellow</u> gate in the carpark and <u>Red</u> gate at Russell Street will open at 8.15am and students wait on the basketball court where they will be supervised by a teacher. From 8.30am children will be able to enter their classrooms in readiness for the day.

Children will sanitise as they enter the classroom.

Parents /Carers will farewell their children at the gates. Foundation children will be supported at the gates and escorted to their classroom if necessary.

Late Arrivals

At 8.45am the <u>Yellow</u> carpark gate will be locked and all late arrivals will need to enter via <u>Red</u> Gate at Russell Street. All visitors and children arriving after 8.45am will need to report to the <u>school office</u>.

Adults who come onsite and remain for over 15 minutes are required to sign in via our Corpus Christi QR code system. QR Code Images are set up near classrooms or you can sign in at the school office.

End of Day Dismissal

All 3 gates will be opened at 2.50pm

Parents can wait on the basketball court or the front lawn from 2.50pm or they can wait at the gates and children will be dismissed from the gates at 3.05pm.

 Children will LINE UP at 3.00pm – Juniors, Seniors and <u>now the Middles</u> will all line up on the Basketball Court.

At the 3.00pm bell, parents / carers can collect their child from their line. All children (including siblings) will wait in their home group line until a parent / carer has come to collect them.

Children who are not collected from the school grounds will be walked to the exit gates at the 3.05pm bell. Siblings will meet at the gate they are leaving from.

PLEASE let your child know which gate you will pick them up from.

ALL Foundation children and their siblings can be picked up from the front lawn area – Foundation children FROM 2.55pm and their siblings FROM 3.00pm. NB Children can be picked up at any time up to 3.05pm.

Russell Street Walker/Riders and those being <u>picked up</u> from <u>Red</u>gate, will exit through <u>Red</u>gate at 3.05pm.

MacKillop Walkers will wait in the Senior area until they are dismissed.

Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) Program children will be led to the MFR by a teacher.

<u>Important</u>

- Parents / carers who pick children up from the schools grounds can use any gate to exit.
- We ask that parents / carers move offsite as quickly and calmly as possible.
- <u>Children are not permitted on the playgrounds at dismissal time.</u>
