COVID UPDATE

Notification of a Positive COVID-19 Case at School

When we receive notification of a positive case of Covid-19 at school I will send a letter to families of affected homegroups or year levels, so children in that group can be monitored closely for symptoms.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

If your child is not experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, they can continue to attend school, but you should monitor for symptoms.

Students who show symptoms of COVID-19 cannot attend school and should get tested immediately and isolate until they receive a negative result.

Students should continue with twice-a-week rapid antigen testing on school days.

Students who have recovered from COVID-19 do not need to participate in surveillance testing for 30 days after their isolation period has ended.

IF YOUR CHILD RETURNS A POSITIVE RESULT, YOUR CHILD HAS COVID-19. YOU MUST:

- quarantine your child for seven days
- advise the school about the positive result
- Your child must stay home until their symptoms have resolved and they are well

Everyone in your household is a close contact and must isolate for 7 days. Household contacts are cleared from quarantine after 7 days, if they get a negative result from a test taken on Day 6.

Reporting your child's positive test

If your child was at school when they were infectious you need to report the positive case through the <u>Student COVID-19 Test Portal</u> or you can notify the school in writing or by phone.

You must also report your child's positive test to the Department of Health via the

COVID-19 Positive Rapid Antigen Test Self-Reporting Form or call centre on 1800 675 398.

Unwell children

Any child who is even slightly unwell should remain at home until they are fit to return to school. It is a requirement for us to contact parents immediately if any child is unwell.

Ventilation

We have received 23 air purifiers, provided by the State Government and 6 ventilators purchased by the school. These have been placed in learning spaces around the school as an added safety measure.

START OF DAY AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Start of Day

Yellow gate in the carpark and red gate at Russell Street will open at 8.15am and children are able to play on the basketball court and on the playgrounds as they wait to go inside. From 8.30am children will be able to enter their classrooms in readiness for the day. Children will sanitise as they enter the classroom.

Parents & carers will farewell their children at the gates. Foundation children will be supported at the gates and escorted to their classroom if necessary.

Late Arrivals

At 8.45am the Yellow carpark gate will be locked and all late arrivals will need to enter via Red Gate at Russell Street. All visitors and children arriving after 8.45am will need to report to the school office.

Adults who come onsite and remain for over 15 minutes are required to sign in via our Corpus Christi QR code system set up near classrooms or by signing in at the school office.

End of Day Dismissal

At dismissal time, all 3 gates will be open from 2.55pm and families can enter the school to pick up their children.

Foundation children and their siblings can be picked up from the front lawn.

Parents & carers can wait on the school basketball court to pick up children in Grades 1 to 6.

Children will be brought to the Carpark - (yellow) gate if they have not been picked up by 3.00pm and can be met there by the person picking them up.

IN SUMMARY:

Foundation children go to the grassed area near carpark gate at 2.55pm.

Siblings of Foundation children go to the grassed area near carpark gate at 3.00pm

<u>Junior, Middle and Senior children</u> will assemble on the <u>basketball court</u> ready to be picked up from 3.00pm.

<u>Russell Street Walkers/Riders and those being picked up</u> from Russell St (red gate), will exit through red gate at 3.05pm.

MacKillop Walkers will wait in the Senior area until they are dismissed.

Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) Program children will be led to the MFR by a teacher.

IMPORTANT

- ⇒ Parents / carers who pick children up from the school grounds can use any gate to exit.
- ⇒ We ask that parents / carers move offsite as quickly and calmly as possible.
- ⇒ Children are asked not to use the playgrounds at dismissal time.

NEW WORKS AND IMPROVEMENTS 2022

New Junior Playground and installation of rubber rock base

A Student Design Team and all Junior students were given an opportunity to provide input and feedback on designs for our junior playground in 2021. (Many elements were included in the final design).

Mr Kyle Dent coordinated the installation of the Rubber Rock base and design around the trees near the playground. The Junior children have made great use of the playground and seem to be really enjoying this new addition to our school!

New Shade Structure over Basketball Court

Our new structure over the basketball court will be erected during term 1. The structure will provide many benefits including shade in summer and shelter in winter as well as being a great area for whole school assemblies and other school events. Work on this project will begin soon with an estimated completion time of April 2022. This will result in modifications to play spaces at break times during Term 1 but we believe the final product will be a great resource and facility for our whole school community.
