CORPUS CHRISTI SCHOOL VALUES AND SPORT HOUSES

At the time of enrolment at Corpus Christi School, each family is allocated to a Sports House. It is important that as a whole school community we are aware of the significance of our Sport House Names, Colours and related School Values.



The House names and colours are as follows;

Portland – Blue MacKillop – Yellow

Penola – Green Woods – Red

SIGNIFICANCE OF THE HOUSE NAMES AND VALUES

Portland: The Victorian town where the idea was born to establish schools that would be run by a special group of dedicated Nuns who would not be under the direct control of local Bishops and would work mainly with the poor. Value: COMMUNITY

Penola: The South Australian town where the first school was established in very humble beginnings, not unlike Corpus Christi in 1985. Value: LEARNING

Woods: Father Julian Woods was the co-founder of the Sisters of St. Joseph and their Spiritual Leader in their early days of formation. Value: SERVICE

MacKillop: Mary MacKillop was the foundress of the Sisters of St. Joseph and is a direct link to the establishment of our own school, Corpus Christi. Mary MacKillop was beatified in 1995, our 10th Anniversary year and Canonised a Saint on 17th October 2010, our 25th Anniversary Year. Value: COURAGE



At the end of each year, four School Leaders and four Sport House Leaders are elected to represent the school in the following school year.

These children are selected from the current Year 5 children. They will be called upon to take on extra duties to help to develop pride and spirit in the school and within their respective sporting teams. They will be a model of good leadership and positive sporting behaviour to the whole school community.

The process for children to apply for these positions takes place in Term 4 of each year.

IMPORTANT - LEARNING COMMUNITY GROUPINGS 2023 ALL CONSIDERATIONS DUE BY - FRIDAY 2ND SEPTEMBER

Staff will be considering Learning Community groupings for 2023 during Term 3. Your child's teacher and all the teachers in your child's level consult frequently about each individual child's development, academically, socially, emotionally, spiritually and physically. When placing your child into a new learning community, your child's Learning Community Home Group teachers are the best people to place your child in a group that enhances your child's learning.

Teachers know the children that work well together and those that may do better when placed apart. Teachers know the children who may need a special 'friend' in their learning community group. Teachers know students' friendship groups. Parents can be invaluable supporters of teachers by ensuring as much information is shared with teachers as possible. This culmination of knowledge will be used to place your child in a Home Group for 2023.

It is vital that any information about your child that you feel is important for teachers to know is communicated directly to your child's teacher by **FRIDAY 2nd SEPTEMBER** as groupings for the 2023 School Year will take place in the last 2 weeks of Term 3.

Shop for Schools Initiative






Senior students completed their own version of Street Art using a manhole cover as inspiration.


